Dermatology specialist centre offers a range of dermatological services. DSC's primary focus is skin cancer and MOHS surgery but with seven Dermatologists working out of two practice location they are able to see a range of dermatology conditions. These include:

Skin cancer

There are several treatments for skin cancer. These methods include excision (surgical removal), curettage and cautery (scraping and burning with an electric needle) radiotherapy (x-rays) and Mohs surgery (microscopically controlled excision). The methods chosen depends on several factors such as location of the cancer, its size and previous therapies.

MOHS surgery

MOHS surgery (microscopically controlled excision) is a surgical technique to remove some type of skin cancers. During the procedure thin layers of the skin are removed and examined under a microscope, the process is repeated until the cancer has been removed completely.

Efudix/Aldara

Efudix/Aldara are topical treatments of superficial pre-malignant and malignant skin lesions

Vermilionectomy

A laser vermilionectomy is a procedure where your specialist removes the superficial cell layers from your lower lip vermilion. The vermilion is the pink part of your lower lip.

General Dermatology

Acne Treatment

Acne is a skin disease that is characterised by blackheads, whiteheads, pimples and greasy skin and may result in scarring. There are a number of treatment options to assist with managing acne in teenagers through to adults.

Hyperhidrosis

Hyperhidrosis refers to increased sweating and may affect any area of the body but is particularly a problem on the hands, armpits and the feet.

Alopecia

Alopecia is the loss of hair on the scalp and elsewhere on the body.

Rosacea

Rosacea is a skin condition that causes the swelling of blood vessels beneath the facial skin, causing redness, spider like blood vessels or acne like blemishes. Flare-ups can be controlled.

Rhinophyma treatment

Sclerotherapy

Sclerotherapy is a procedure to eliminate varicose veins and spider veins. It involves injections direction in to the vein

Cosmetic Dermatology

Photodynamic therapy

Photorejuvenation with Ellipse I2PL utilises multiple wavelengths (different colours) of light in a single flash to target both the redness (blood in vessels) and pigmentation (melanin) in sun damaged skin. This leads to a fresher, smoother and more vital looking skin with a healthy sheen. It will not eliminate deep wrinkles but can soften fine lines.

Filler Injections

Filler injections are a cosmetic procedure used to help smooth out wrinkles or pitted scars on the skin.

CO2 laser

The CO2 laser is used for resurfacing and can help reduce wrinkles and blemishes

Botox

Botox is most commonly used as improving the appearance of wrinkles on the face. It can also be used to treat muscle stiffness, muscle spasms and prevent migraines.

Hair Removal - IPL

An Ellipse I2PL laser can be used to hair removal in cosmetically sensitive areas
